Meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Supervisor Charles Maziasz. Pledge was recited by all.

Additions/Deletions to agenda – Addition to new business: Hall Ramp. Motion by Steve Crusoe, seconded by Scott Eno, to approve the agenda for the May 14th meeting with one addition. **Motion Carried.**

Information Reports

Brent Shank – County Road Commission – Road Manager here to discuss bids received last month on Baker, Little Canada, and Long Lake roads. Discussion followed on all three roads. Questions raised by Board, 1) Use pit run than 22A gravel, 2) Who uses road, 3) Best value for Township Dollars. Asphalt on Long Lake Road was removed from discussion until future date. Motion by Charles Veneros, seconded by Steve Crusoe, to work on Baker Road, not to exceed \$40,000 with a match of ½ half or \$20,000 from County Road Commission. Motion Carried. Discussion followed on Little Canada and the flooding that took place during last rains. Road was almost washed out. Motion by Charles Veneros, seconded by Scott Eno, to do estimated project starting 1100 feet north of Baker Road then 2450 feet, total estimate was \$166,400 and County Road will pay \$25000, so cost to Township will be \$141400. Motion Carried.

Roberta Matelski – Jail expansion build has started. Solar panel issue from Grant Township is in the hands of Zoning. Visited Humane Society. Recycling renewal with Townships complete. On ballot in August should be County Road millage and senior millage.

Mary Crusoe - Library Representative – All fire extinguishers replaced. Children’s library position is being offered because of retirement of Mr. Kane. Budget hearing coming up.
