

Aloha Township
Regular Board Meeting at Aloha Township Hall
May 10, 2021 7:00 P.M.

Present: Supervisor Chuck Maziasz, Trustee Steve Crusoe, Clerk Teresa Sullivan, Treasurer Charles Veneros, Trustee Scott Eno.

Meeting was called to order by Chuck Maziasz, Supervisor at 7:00 pm by. Pledge of allegiance recited.

Additions/Deletions to agenda – Motion by Steve Crusoe, seconded by Scott Eno to approve agenda with 3 new additions: Aloha Historical Society, FIOA and SAM#, and one deletion: old business – Road improvement list. All ayes.

Information Reports –

Roberta Matelski - reported on updates at the Cheboygan County Commission.

Mary Crusoe – updated news at the library. Mary stated it was her last library meeting because she is not seeking reappointment as Aloha Township Representative after her term expires in June 2021.

Action Items:

Library Representative – Discussion on Mary Crusoe’s replacement for Aloha. It was discussed that Mark Bronson could possibly have a list of interested applicants. Steve Crusoe, Chuck Maziasz and Ed Delana also said that they have possible prospects. To be tabled until next month

Blight complaints – Chuck Maziasz, Supervisor tried to contact the Peter’s residence and will continue. Marcle complaint has been taken care of.

Consent Agenda – Motion by Steve Crusoe, seconded by Scott Eno to accept the consent agenda, April 12, 2021 minutes, April Financial Report, Township expenditures in the amount of \$9,294.01 and Oak Hill cemetery expenditures in the amount of \$1,418.76. All ayes. Motion carried. Teresa Sullivan, Clerk stated that the ending general checking fund of \$92,638.51 balances to the bank statement, however there has been an outstanding check from Alverno Fire Department in the amount of \$64,730.98 and that the actual available balance in the account is \$27,907.53.

Correspondence – Cheboygan County Road Commission, CCRC 2020 Annual Report and an email response from Brent Shank regarding the village streets in Aloha.

Meeting Report- Charlie Veneros submitted the meeting minutes from the Cheboygan County Road Commission meetings. No questions asked. Chuck Maziasz stated he will be the contact person for the CCRC when Charlie Veneros leaves.

Old Business

AT&T- Teresa Sullivan, Clerk is still working out discrepancies with AT&T. Representative stated he will monitor account.

Charlie Veneros, Treasurer asked to remove the road improvement list from the agenda because he felt that the Board has not given any consideration on improvements needed.

Website – Chuck Maziasz will update on the status of the website at the next meeting. He stated that he will be the contact person.

New Business

Gravel pit – Chuck Maziasz commented that the pit is getting filled up. Merchant and Everingham Excavating said that they would push back all the debris from the front of the entrance.

Presque Gas & Electric Company– They will be updating meters to smart meters, no manual readings.

Long Lake update – Chuck Maziasz to hold a meeting with the Association.

May 4th election update – Teresa Sullivan Clerk updated activity for the May election. There were 227 absentee applications mailed with 107 ballots requested, 82 ballots were returned, 7 returned undeliverable for temporary away, 3 received after election and 25 walk-in voters.

Aloha Historical Society – Teresa Sullivan was informed that the Historical Society has all their documents stored at the Aloha store and asked if it could be stored at the hall. Steve Crusoe stated that there is so much artifacts and documents that the hall has no room. Charlie Veneros stated that we should not get involved because it is a separate entity. Chuck Maziasz said there were books published that the township funded and will check if we can get the books.

FIOA – Teresa Sullivan stated that she received two FIOA requests regarding the March and November 2020 election.

SAM# - Charlie Veneros will apply for the numbers needed to receive any grant money that the American Rescue Plan has allotted for Aloha.

Land Splits – Motion by Charlie Veneros, seconded by Steve Crusoe to accept the land splits requested by Corey Ommen for parcel 140-020- 206-051-00 located on 2933 N M-33 Hwy.

Ed Delana complemented on the election process and had a question regarding the Long Lake assessment.
